## FICTION

- **Higuera, Donna Barba. *The Last Cuentista*. 2021. Gr 6 Up.**

Four hundred years after she's put into cryosleep on a generation ship, 12-year-old Petra wakes up to find that the monitors tasked with caring for the ship's passengers have taken over--and she's the only one who remembers life on Earth.

- **Sepetys, Ruta. *I Must Betray You*. 2022. Gr 8 Up.**

Set in 1989, Sepetys's newest book covers one Romanian teen's struggle against the brutal dictator Nicolae Ceaușescu.

## GRAPHIC NOVELS

- **Keys, Alicia. *Girl on Fire*. 2022. Gr 8 Up.**

A black teen superhero from the housing projects of Brooklyn comes into her own.

- **Takei, George. *They Called Us Enemy*. 2019. Gr 6 Up.**

Former *Star Trek* star George Takei recounts his childhood spent in a Japanese American internment camp during World War II.

## NONFICTION

- **Coker, Jessika. *Juniper, the Happiest Fox*. 2018. All Ages.**

A photo book about Juniper, a rescue fox who lives in a Florida animal sanctuary with other rescued exotic animals.

- **Greenfield, Amy Butler. *The Woman All Spies Fear: Code Breaker Elizebeth Smith Friedman and Her Hidden Life*. 2021. Gr 8 Up.**

A biography of a little-known American cryptanalyst, Elizebeth Smith Friedman, who helped break enemy codes during World Wars I and II.
